Passage: Mark 14:43-50

Ps 55:12-13 “12 For it is not an enemy who reproaches me, then I could bear it; nor is it one who hates me who has exalted himself against me, then I could hide myself from him. 13 But it is you, a man my equal, my companion and my familiar friend”

Matt 7:22-23 “22 Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’ 23 ‘And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.’”

THERE WERE TWO POSSIBLE MOTIVES FOR JUDAS’ BETRAYAL OF JESUS

a. P_____ P_____

John 6:15 “So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and take Him by force to make Him king, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone”

John 6:70 “(Jesus Said) Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve, and yet one of you is a devil?” (Emphasis Added)

b. F_____ G_____

John 12:4-5 “4 But Judas Iscariot, one of His disciples, who was intending to betray Him, said, 5 ‘Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii and given to poor people?’”

John 12:6 “Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it”

Matt 27:3-7 (Reference)

Acts 1:18 “Now this man acquired a field with the price of his wickedness, and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his intestines gushed out”

Luke 22:48 "(Jesus Said)... 'Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?'"

Acts 1:23-25 "23 So they put forward two men, Joseph called Barsabbas (who was also called Justus), and Matthias. 24 And they prayed and said, "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all men, show which one of these two You have chosen 25 to occupy this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place."

a. This Was a Reference to His J_____.

Matt 11:21-22 "21 Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles had occurred in Tyre and Sidon which occurred in you, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. 22 'Nevertheless I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the day of judgment than for you'"

b. This Was a Reference to His F_____.

Acts 2:23 "this Man (Jesus), delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death."

Luke 22:22 "For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!"

i. Jesus Appealed to Judas With K_____

John 13:10-11 "10 Jesus said to him (Peter), 'He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.' 11 For He knew the one who was betraying Him; for this reason He said, 'Not all of you are clean.'"

John 13:18 "I do not speak of all of you. I know the ones I have chosen; but it is that the Scripture may be fulfilled, 'HE WHO EATS MY BREAD HAS LIFTED UP HIS HEEL AGAINST ME.'"

Matt 26:25 "And Judas, who was betraying Him, said, "Surely it is not I, Rabbi?" Jesus *said to him, "You have said it yourself."

ii. Jesus Appealed to Judas With L_____

John 13:21 "When Jesus had said this, He became troubled in spirit, and testified and said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, that one of you will betray Me."

2 Pet 3:9 "The Lord is...not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance."

1 Tim 2:4 "who (God) desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."
